REPORT ON NSS SPECIAL CAMP HELD FROM 23.02.2015 TO 01.03. 2015 AT GANDHINAGAR (VILLAGE), SURYAPET (MANDAL) NALGONDA.

NSS unit of Sri Venkateswara Engineering College suryapet organized a seven day special camp in the adopted village, Gandhinagar from 23rd February 2015 to 01st March 2015.

The number of student - volunteers participated in the camp was 51. The Volunteers of the NSS unit performed many activities — awareness programmes as literacy, tree plantation, health and hygiene, construction and repairs, communal harmony etc.

$\underline{\text{Day}} - 1$

The forenoon session of the Day began with a Procession by volunteers in the village. Volunteers rallied into the streets of the villages to create awareness among the villagers about the ensuing special camp programme in their village for a period of one week. This was followed by an inauguration Programm held at Grampanchayat office of Gandhi Nagar Village. MPP of Suryapet Sri Vatte Janaiah attended the programme as Chief Guest. Principal of Sri Venkateswara Engineering College Dr.A.Srujana, Sarpanch of the Village Smt.V.Renuka, Vicesarpanch Jebunnisa Begam,Ex Vice-sarpanch Sri Chandpasha and several village people attended the function. Village authorities welcomed the team of Volunteers into their village and assured them all sorts of co-operation needed in making the special camp a success.

During the Afternoon of the First Day Volunteers interacted with Village people and visited the people in their houses discussed about their needs and requirements . Volunteers created awareness through door to door campaign on cleanliness, spread of diseases, importance of environment and judicious use of Electricity and water harvesting and importance of ground water

Day - 2

The Second Day camp began with Shramadanam Programme by Volunteers. About 50 volunteers divided themselves into sub groups and went into the streets, lanes and by lanes of the village and organized a cleanliness drive. Volunteers cleaned the village roads, removed dust heaps and cleared the stagnant drainage flows and attempted to create an awareness on Cleanliness and hygiene. They sweeped with brooms on the roads of the village. The sprayed bleaching powder in drains Some villagers joined volunteers and participated with enthusiasm.

In the following Session , a Personality Development Programme was organized. A full length discussion was initiated and Faculty Members from the college joined in the programme. A Brain storming session was organized. Thoughts and ideas were exchanged on Leadership quality and Team Spirit and importance of collective responsibility in achieving common goals of community service.

Day - 3

The Forenoon Session of third day began with Shramadanam. Volunteers Cleaned Roads all the lanes of the village were leveled and drainages were cleared and stagnant water was allowed to flow freely. Pits were dug in the ground along both sides of the approach road of the village for ensuing Plantation Programme on the following day. About 150 pits were dug by volunteers and ground was made thoroughly ready for plantation.

All the volunteers assembled at Grampanchayat Office after the the lunch break. In order to create awareness on fundamental legal issues among villagers and public, a legal awareness session was organized. Additional Public Prosecutor of Suryapet Muncif court, Sri J.Shashidar and Govt.Pleader Mr.Hasan visited the camp site and spoke with volunteers and villagers. Later Sri J.Shashidar addressed the gathering. Principal of the college Dr.A.Srujana and some faculty members also joined the programme.

Day - 4

The fourth day of the camp was mainly dedicated on Plantation Programme. Volunteers collected about 200 saplings from nearby Nursaries and brought them into the village and started planting saplings. All the volunteers formed several groups of 4-5 and were advised to plant two saplings in the gardens, courtyards and safe places of every house in the village . MPP of suryapet and village sarpanch smt.Renuka and vice-sarpanch Jebunnisa begum and Primary School Head Master also participated in the programme. The Principal of the College Dr.A.Srujana, Prof. of CSE Dr.Madhavi encouraged the volunteers and villagers by joining the plantation programme.

In the afternoon an awareness programme on environment was conducted. A Group Discussion programme on impact of Green House effect and Global warming was organized and volunteers shared their views with enthusiasm and all the volunteers arrived at common conclusion about the role of human beings in protecting the environment. Program officer and Asst.Prof. sri KVLN pavan and Asst.Prof. Vazed Ahmed addressed the volunteers.

Day - 5

The Subject of fifth day camp was creation of healthy society through community health services. Topmost priority was given to Free Eye Treatment to underprivileged Rural People. Lions Club of Suryapet accepted our request of our NSS Unit and deputed a team of doctors in a mobile van into the village. A public announcement was made and door to door communication is given by our volunteers to inform people to avail free health services. The response was excellent and about 150 village people came forward eye screening and about 30 people were identified as suffering with Cataract. Around 15 persons were immediately taken to Lions club hospital suryapet and Free surgeries were done to village people at the cost of Lions Club Hospital.

After the Lunch Break the service was continued till evening. On the other hand Noted Gynecologist of the Town Dr.Durgabai accepted request of our NSS Unit and visited the village and extended free health check up for women. About 50 women availed the service and Free Medicine was supplied to Patients on behalf of Satyasai Seva Samiti.

$\underline{\text{Day}} - \underline{6}$

In continuation to Previous Day Programme, the Forenoon Session of 6th Day was dedicated to Dental Health Screening of the Villagers and Children in Primary School of the village. The Principal, Kamineni Institute of Dental Science, Narketpally accepted the request made by NSS Unit of our college and deputed a team of staff members including doctors in a mobile van into the village. Villages were informed through public announcement and door to door information by volunteers. Around 100 village people and 84 school children and volunteers and staff members availed the opportunity. Free dental cleaning and flossing etc services were extended by the team. People with Teeth Disorders were given option to visit the clinic for free surgical treatment at the cost of institute.

Some volunteers were engaged in cleaning the premises of Village Hanuman Temple and Road was leveled by the White soil brought from agricultural wells. Temple was cleaned neatly and pooja was performed by volunteers.

In the afternoon an Awareness Programme on Dental Health was organized in Village School. All the Students were addressed by Doctors and they were educated about primary precautions to protect Dental Health. Charts and Drawaing Boards and Audio Visual Aids were used by the doctors to educate volunteers and School Kids.

Volunteers collected Donation to supply Note Books, Pens, Compass Boxes, and Erasers etc. essential school necessities in school education to under privileged poor rural students. All Students of Govt. Primary School of Gandhinagar were given the said material. The Head Master of the School appreciated the effort made by the volunteers and Staff of School and Students thanked the Volunteers. The Principal of the College and Prof & Head of the CSE Dept. joined the volunteers in distribution programme. Sarpanch of the village appreciated volunteers and programme officer for this charity service.

$\underline{\mathbf{Day}} - 7$

The seventh day was the closing day of the camp. The day began with awareness processions on the subject of Prohibition of Alcohol and communal Harmony. All the volunteers organized a Rally and went through the streets of the village ,sang slogans, raised banners and placards about prohibition of Alcohol and Smoking. Volunteers watered the plants and made fencing for the saplings and explained householders to protect the plants. Sarpanch and Village authorities also joined hands with volunteers for some time.

The second session of the day was allotted to valedictory function. The function was presided over by Dr.Srujana Prinicpal of the college. MPP of Suryapet Sri V.janaiah, village sarpanch smt. Vatte Renuka, Jebunnisa Begum Vice-President of the village and Ward Counsellors and Ex vice-president Sri Chand Pasha and Faculty Members Vazid Ahmed and Sri KVLN Pavan Kumar, Mr.Prakash Babu attended the function. Program Officer Sri P.Krishna Murthy addressed the gathering and explained about various service activities undertaken during their 7 days period of stay in the village. Principal appreciated the Volunteers and staff for their work and thanked the village authorities for their support. MPP Sri V.Janaiah profusely thanked the volunteers and program officer and the Management of the college for their various service activities and assured all sorts of co-operation in their future operations as an adopted village.
